The Bank of Marin is hosting the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual fund-raising art event to benefit Petaluma Arts Association and Petaluma People's Service Center on **Thursday, April 6, 2006**. The proceeds from this event go to local schools in the form of Grants/Scholarships. We gave out \$1300 for Grants/Scholarships that were the proceeds of sales from The Spirit Of Color event for 2005.

**POSTER CONTEST:** Art will be chosen for a poster and printed to commemorate The Spirit Of Color event. You may enter up to 4 photographs or slides, if you are a painter, a Sonoma County resident, and a member of **The Petaluma Arts Association** or **The Petaluma Arts Council**. A panel of three artists will jury the contest. There is no entry fee. Deadline for entries is Nov. 2, 2005. Posters will be reproduced & printed from the chosen art. They will be for sale proceeding, during, and
