Library Show 2007

PAINT FAST! PAY YOUR 2007 PAA DUES!! THE LIBRARY SHOW IS COMING UP!

The Library Show, sponsored by PAA and the Friends of the Library at 100 Fairgrounds Drive, will run from February 8 through February 16th, 2007. Show hours for the public are: Thursday, 2/8 and Fri. 2/9 from 10 am to 5 pm. Sat. 2/10 from 10 am to 4 pm. Mon. 2/12 from 10 am to 5 pm. Tues. 2/13 and Wed. 2/14 from 10 am to 8 pm. (Wednesday, 2/14 will feature an artists' reception from 7 – 8 pm.) Thurs. 2/15 from 10 am to 5 pm. Fri. 2/16 from 10 am to 1 pm. The show closes at 1 pm that day.

Criteria for show (This is not a juried show. However, at the discretion of the committee, a piece may be rejected due to not being suitable for all ages.):

1. Current member of Petaluma Arts Association. Dues paid for 2007.
2. Artist must be a docent at the show for minimum of 2 hours (Sign up sheet available.)
3. Art work:
 - a. Two-dimensional work cannot be larger than 28" x 28"; if larger, artist must provide an easel to display the artwork. (2 piece limit for each artist.)
 - b. Three-dimensional work (No limit on number of pieces.)
 - c. Other types of art: please call Virginia (707)766-8714 to see if there are restrictions on the number of pieces.
4. Art work will be received at the library community room on:
 - a. Tuesday, 2/6 between 6 pm to 7 pm
 - b. Wednesday, 2/7 between 12 noon to 1:30 pmWhen checking in pieces of art, please complete the form that is provided. The form will require the following information:
Artist # (provided by person accepting art work), Phone #, Artist signature (legible, please), Title of art, Medium, Price or NFS, Docent Date & Time.
5. Art work must be picked up at the library community room on:
Feb. 16 between the hours of 1 pm to 2:30 pm.
If unable to pickup, please arrange to have someone pick it up for you during these hours.
